- 1 The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and taken on record by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on August 4, 2011.
- 2 In continuation of the ongoing dispute pertaining to the KST, KVAT and CST, the Company has received total demand notices amounting to Rs. 6928.15 lakhs for the period from April 2002 to March 2010. The Company has paid Rs. 3128.47 lakhs as cash under protest and furnished Bank Guarantee amounting to Rs. 3579.58 lakhs. The Company has preferred appeals before the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal/ Appellate Authority and as the matter is sub-judice and pending resolution, no amounts have been provided in the accounts.

- 4 Provision for Income Tax for the Quarter ended June 30, 2011 has been computed on the basis of Minimum Alternate Tax (MAT) in accordance with Section 115JB of The Income Tax Act, 1961, and is net of MAT Credit availed of Rs.15 lakhs.
- 5 On April 21, 2011, the shareholders of the Company have approved through Postal ballot process, the issue of one equity share of face value of Rs 10/- each as bonus share for every one share held by the equity shareholders of the Company whose name appear in the register of members as on the record date, by capitalisation of Securities premium account. Subsequently, the Bonus shares have been allotted on 5th May 2011. Basic and Diluted Earnings Per Share (EPS) have been restated for all the corresponding periods to give effect of the said issue of Bonus shares, in accordance with Accounting Standard (AS) 20 "Earnings Per Share" notified under Section 211(3C) of the Companies Act, 1956.
- 6 The Company is engaged in providing value added services in telecom business and its operations are considered to constitute a single segment in the context of Accounting Standard 17 - "Segment Reporting".
- 7 Previous period figures have been reclassified/ regrouped wherever necessary.
